Hundreds of full-time working parents are without childcare options (unless of course, they're fortunate enough to have a grandparent or other relative/friend who is familiar with the child's special needs).

If our children had disabilities and couldn't attend those centers, we would be forced to live on one income and our financial situation would be detrimental to our family.
